Regular universal forklift buckets connect to blades which are up to 6" wide and are 48" long. Bigger fork pockets could be ordered through an account manager upon request.

For the reason that universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the blades directly, they stay on the machine and are a lot less susceptible to damage. These buckets are also 50 percent deeper than the quick-tach bucket models. This extra space makes them perfect for lifting irregular shaped loads like moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.

A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces strength, resistance to damage and provides supreme durability. Quick-Tach lift buckets can in various situations replace the blades and carriage of a lift truck, which may weigh anywhere between one hundred to seven hundred pounds. These buckets when set up can free up more load capacity, enabling it to deal with both bigger and heavier stuff. The Quick-Tach can dump items more or less 1.5 feet higher because of the shorter depth of its bucket.
