They provide an inexpensive answer for companies which do not require them frequently. These platforms have a railing system in place, tie offs and skid proof decking accessible. They still require the use of safety machines by staff but come with these specific features to be able to further the safety of individuals who will be utilizing them. Slip-on work platforms are an excellent alternative for those projects which take place in difficult places or over top of an object.

A pin system fastens this particular kind of platform onto your lift truck after sliding the platform on. The industrial hoist stand provides extra protection in view of the fact that they are outfitted with railings on three sides and a safety screen in the back. For additional safety, it is a better idea to consider selecting a kind that opens through the front railing as opposed to the side gate model.

Stock pickers can attach onto a lift truck using the same mechanisms as other platforms but are a lot different. Stock pickers normally have a much smaller support surrounding by a front protector partition and railings on three sides. This model differs from the various platforms because the surface and the cage do not take up the whole fork surface area.

Combination platforms have proven to be very helpful whenever staff need to work with materials a height. This style of platform has a smaller and larger section. This design is essential so that staff could finish their task and not have to worry themselves about any materials sliding onto them if the individual operating it tilts or tips the objects.

There are lots of attachments available that can attach to your platform that will improve its efficiency even more. These racks keep materials like for example pipes, brooms as well as various objects from falling off of the platform and hitting other employees. For additional performance, there are toolboxes, trays and tools designed to mount directly onto the side of the guardrails.
